Food and Snacks

We are a health promoting school. Fizzy drinks and large bags of sweets/crisps are discouraged in favour of healthy snacks. We are **a nut free zone** due to allergies. Also due to allergies and intolerances, we discourage the children from sharing snacks (although we appreciate this is very kind!)

Children are encouraged to bring a filled bottle of water to school each day and have access to this during class time.

We have a fruit beak every afternoon and children are welcome to bring a piece of fruit from home to enjoy at this time.

Children can order a meal in our canteen for lunch or bring a packed lunch. All children in P1-P5 are entitled to free school meals. Milk can be ordered via Parent Pay.
