A breakfast club runs daily from our school canteen and is **free of charge** for all children. Earliest entry for this is **8.15am** and latest entry is 8.40am. Children can choose from Weetabix or toast, water or milk and yoghurt or fresh fruit. Parents are asked not to enter the dining hall during breakfast club. Please note that there is no playground supervision prior to 8.45am.

Fruit Break

Children are given the opportunity to have a fruit snack every afternoon. Fruit should be taken from home but we will try our best to supply children with fruit if they have forgotten theirs!

Allergy Reminder

Please remember that nuts and nut containing products are not allowed in school as we have children who suffer from allergies.
