Uniform

Once again thank you for your support in sending your child to school in their school uniform. Uniform is beneficial for helping to build identity, raising expectations and also promotes equality among our children. Our school uniform is **grey** trousers or skirt, white shirt with tie and a bottle green jumper or cardigan. We also ask that where possible, children bring a change of indoor shoes for during the day. The PE kit is a red polo shirt and black shorts/leggings/joggers. If you are finding it difficult to provide uniform for your child, please get in touch as we can help. Children are discouraged from wearing acrylic nail extensions and make up to school.

Phones

Parents are reminded that children are not permitted to have phones turned on during the school day. If a child is required to bring a phone to school this needs to be turned off on entering the grounds and remain turned off throughout the day. The same applies to smart watches. These should be disabled or have school hour settings applied so they are not active during the school day. Please note that these items are taken to school at the pupils' own risk.

Dogs

A gentle reminder that it is a council wide request that dogs are not permitted on school grounds.

P7 residential trip

Our Primary 7 will be going on their residential trip to Ardentinny Outdoor Centre week beginning the 5th February.

As a group of our staff will be taking part on the trip to supervise the children, there will be some changes to staffing in classes during this week but we aim to keep any disruptions to a minimum.
