School Uniform and Belongings

For health and safety reasons all jewellery should be removed for PE lessons. If earrings cannot be removed, they should be covered with tape.

A reminder that acrylic nail extensions are not suitable for pupils in school and are a health and safety risk in the playground and gym hall.

Mobile Phones

Please note that pupils are not permitted to use mobile phones during the school day. If bringing a phone to school, children do so at their own risk. Any phones brought to school must be switched off on entering the school grounds. If your child owns a smart watch, you must ensure that call/messaging and photography/recording are not enabled during the school day. Many of these devices have 'school settings' which we would recommend.

Drop Off and Pick Up arrangements

Children should continue to be dropped off/ enter at the school gates by the roundabout and crossing patrol in the mornings, no earlier than 8.50am. Supervision is not available in the playground before this time.

From 2.50pm, the school gates will be opened and parents can access the playground for end of day pick up. Parents are asked to wait towards the back of the yard to help safely dismiss children at 3pm.

A gentle reminder that parents are not permitted in the playground before 9. Parents are also asked to please be courteous towards our neighbours and park in a safe and responsible manner. The school car park should be avoided and parents are reminded that the school bus needs access in the morning and at the end of the day.

School Bus and after school care

Please email the school office to confirm end of day arrangements for your child if you will be making use of after school care or transport. This helps us to ensure safe dismissal at the end of the day.

Medication

If your child requires medication in school then a medical form needs to be completed at the school office. Please remember that medication should never be stored in a child's bag and should be handed into the office for safe keeping.

Health Promoting School

Water

Children are encouraged to bring a filled bottle of water each day. Water is also available at lunchtime from the canteen.

Fruit Break

We have a fruit break in school at 2pm every day. Children are encouraged to bring a piece of fruit to enjoy at this time.

Healthy Snack Options

Please refrain from sending extra large bags of sweets or crisps to school with your child. Fizzy drinks are not permitted. Please also note that **lollipops** pose a choking risk, especially in the playground, therefore these should be avoided. Parents are also reminded that due to allergies, **we are a nut free zone.**

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is open every morning from 8.15am. Please note children should not arrive before this time. Breakfast club is free of charge and operates on a drop in basis.

Paper copies will be sent to Primary 1 in the next couple of days, everyone else will have theirs sent via ParentPortal. Please look out for these.

Formal homework will be distributed week beginning Monday 26th August.
